ever have either by Will or Deed I leave to be Equally divided between Two
of my Sons and as they come of Age the Eldest to have his first choice and
the Next Eldest to have his Choice Either the remainder of the Land in
Chesterfield County or the Land whereon I now live And the Youngest Son
to have that piece of Land left in Chesterfield or the Land and Plantation
whereon I now live. I am I leave what Personal Estate is left me in
Chesterfield County as well as what it has pleas'd God to Indue me with
in this County to the Use of my loving Wife as well the Slaves as the other
part of my Estate for the Support of my Wife and Children And when my
Children come of Age or marryd Then to be Equally divided among them
And I do hereby Constitute and appoint my Wife And her Brother Henry
Thompson and Joseph Farley Junr. "Executors" with my Wife Execut^{trix} of this my
last Will and Testament. Whereunto I have set my hand and Seal this
Twenty second Day of August One thousand seven hundred and fifty six
