of Sound memory and understanding but frail and weak and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die do make this my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following that is to say.

HeM I give and bequeath unto Daniel Jones my bed and furniture and
my share of the Crop now growing.

HeM It is my will and Desire that all the rest of my Estate both Real and
Personal be sold by my executor hereafter mentioned and the money arising
therefrom to be Equally Divided Between my seven Brothers. I amely Thomas
James Christopher Robert Allen Henry Wood Hinton to them and their
Heirs forever I constitute and appoint my Loving Brother Thomas Hinton
Executor of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this Twenty sixth day of August 1760.
