Money my Land shall fetch when sold to him and his heirs forever.

He m. I give and Bequeath unto my son Robert Hulme one Negro
man named Jan which he has been serving.

He m. I give and Bequeath unto my son Charles Hulme one half of the
Money my Land shall fetch when sold to him and his heirs forever.

He m. My Will and Demand is that my Executors hereafter mentioned
sell the Land where I now live and pay the money as before willed to my
two sons John Hulme and Charles Hulme.

He m. I give and Bequeath all the rest of my Estate unto my wife Mary
my Debt paid, to be Equally divided among my eight Children. Be it

That I name, William Hulme, Thomas Hulme, Ann Hulme, John Hulme,
Robert Hulme, Charles Hulme, and Mary Hulme.

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my sons Beil Hulme, William
Hulme and Thomas Hulme Executors of this my last Will.

I do hereby revoke all other Wills by me heretofore made
in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal this sixth Day of November M DCC L X.

money my land shall fetch when sold to him and his heirs forever.

He M. Hulme and Beg. with that my executors hereafter mentioned
sell the land where I now live and pay the money as before null to my
sons John Hulme and Charles Hulme.

He M. Hulme and Beg. with all the rest of my private and public money
my Debt paid, to be equally divided among my eight children: Ben-

Jane, William Hulme, Thomas Hulme, Ann Hulme, John Hulme,
Robert Hulme, Charles Hulme, and Mary Hulme.

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my sons Ben Hulme William
Hulme and Thomas Hulme executors of this my last Will and

testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made.
