as followeth. I Give and devise to my Nephew Woodley Thomas the
Land I now live on Containing three hundred acres more or less
to him and his Heirs for ever also two Negroes Past & Mole
I Give & Devise to my Nephew Athanahous Thomas Two Horses
Eleven head of Cattle & fifteen head of Hogs & such Bed & furniture
Lastly I nominate and appoint Samuell Thomas to be Executor of this
my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking and making Void all
other Wills and Testaments by me at any time ^{heretofore} made In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty first
Day of May Anno Domini 1756
