In the Name of God Amen the Twelfth Day August
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
fifty three Roger Neale of Boyly parish in the County of Amelia
Gentleman being very sick and weak in Body but of perfect
Mind and Memory thanks be given unto God the Father calling
to Mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing it is
appointed for all Men once to die do make and declare this
my last Will and Testament that as to every thing presently and
first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of
Almighty God that gave it and for my Body I recommend it to
the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and secret manner
to the direction of my Executors nothing doubting but at the
General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God: and as touching such worldly estate
wherein it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give
and Bequeath and dispose of the same in the following manner
and form

I give unto my son John Neale the lower half of my tract of
land lying on the River, Branch and two Cows and calves and
a Horse two Cows and pigs and the lower half of my land lying upon
Tanton River at the Mouth of Whipping Creek to him and his heirs forever
I give unto my son Stephen Neale the upper half of each of the several tracts
of land above mentioned and two Cows and calves and two horses and
a Horse to him and his heirs forever.

I give unto my Daughter Anne Neale my Negro Man Harry one
feather bed and Furniture one set two Dishes one Bacon and half
dozen plates and one tract of land lying on Tanton River above
Whipping Creek and two Cows and calves to her and her heirs forever.

I give unto my Daughter Mary Neale my Negro Man Jimmy and
one tract of land Furniture one set two Dishes one Bacon and

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Shipping brack and two cows and calves
I give unto my Daughter Mary Neall my Negro Man Tommy and
a Feather Bed and a Furniture one pair two Dickson's Boxen and
half a dozen plates two Cows and Calves two pigs one Horse to be
and his Wro for ever. Item I give to my Daughter Margut Burks one Cow and
I give and Bequeath to Catharine Neall my Dear and Loving wife the best of
my Estate not mentioned in the Will after my Debts and funeral Charges
are paid I Do make and appoint my Dear Son John Neall my only and
sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament as Witness my hand and
seal the Day and year above Written
and Declared to be my last Will and Testament
