one shilling Sterling to him & his Heirs for ever.

Also I give and Bequeeth to my well Beloved Daughter Hannah
Year bought one shilling Sterling to her & her Heirs for ever.

Also I give and Bequeeth to my grand Son Edward Jorden Son
to Samuel Jorden the Choices of the Feather Beds and furniture
and all that is upon his Plantation at Couches Creek in
Sunnenburg County that belongs to me which is the Negroes
and halfe the Stock I give unto him and his Heirs for ever.

Also I give and Bequeeth to my grand Son Samuel Jorden &
to William Jorden y^e same or Plantation whereon I now live all
and my Negroes gal Sarah to him and the Heirs of his Body.

Sunnenburg County that belongs to me which is the Negroes
and halfe the stock I give unto him and his Heir for ever.

Also I give and Bequeeth to my Grand Sun Samuel Jurden
to William Jurden y^e manor Plantation whereon I now dwell
and my Negron gal Sarah to him and the Heir of his Body
Lovingfully Begotten for ever.

I Also give and Bequeeth to my above mentioned Grand Sun
Samuel Jurden Sun to William Jurden all the Remainder of
my Estate within & without when he arrives to the
age of Twenty one year and that my heirs keep it in their
possession tel he arrives to the age of Twenty one year.

Also Appoint Sudwell Beaten and Richard Clough Trustees
and Executors of this my last Will and Testament and do hereby
Utterly dis Allow Revocate and Disannul all and every other former
Testaments Wills Sequeces and Bequests and Execution by me in
any ways before Named will ed and Bequethed Ratified and
Confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament
In Witness whereoff I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
twenty first day of December One thousand seven hundred and
sixty

Winn and Richard Ellis their Securities as the Laws direct Certificate
was granted them for obtaining a Probate in due Form.
