Money to be paid by my Executors.

Item I give to my son William Crawley one Chest of Drawers which
has on it a Case.

Item I desire that my Daughters Mary Morgan and Sarah Burton
my Executors should equally divide themselves.

Item I give to my Daughter Mrs. Anne my Saddle, Saddle-bags
and Furniture which I have at my son in Law William
with the use of one Negro Girl named Nancy & her increase during her
Natural Life and if my said son in Law William shall have any
Term or against my Estate I desire it may be accounted with in
the Legacy & given to his Wife and not to come out of my last part of my
Estate for satisfaction hereof.

Item I give to my grand Daughter Mary Kate one small Cow.

Item my desire is that after the Death of my Daughter Anne the
Negro Girl Nancy and her increase should equally divide among my
grand children, to wit Mr. Henry, Mr. George, Mr. William, Mr. John, Mr. James
and Mr. Robert.

Item I desire that my Daughters Mary Morgan and Anne shall
my Executors shall equally divide on themselves.

Item I give to my Daughter Mrs. Anne my double bed room
and Furniture which I have at my son in Law William
with the use of one Negro Girl named Nancy & her increase during her
Natural Life and if my said Son in Law William shall have any
Demand against my Estate I desire it may be accounted for with
the Legacy &queath'd his Wife, and not to come out of my
Estate for satisfaction thereof.

Item I give to my Grand Daughter Mary Kate one small Trunk.

Item my Desire that after the Death of my Daughter Anne that the
Negro Girl Nancy and her increase be equally divided among my
Grandchildren viz. John, Mary and Elizabeth which I give to
them to have in power.

Item I give to my Son James Chappell one Negro Man named Larry to
be, paying his Brother John Chappell the sum of Thirty Pounds Current
Money then he said I will give to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I give my Stocks of all kinds together with all my other Estate
not heretofore mentioned to be equally divided among my Son John
James Chappell which I give to them and their Heirs forever.
Lastly, I constitute and appoint my Executors John Chappell

At a Court hold for Amelia County the 22 Day of January 1761.

acknowledged Bond with John Ford his Security as the Law directs for the full
and true performance of the said Will and for obtaining a Probate in due Form Liberty being reserved
to the said James the other Executor to join in the Probate when he shall think
fit.
