Wm Oediah, Thomas & Oney, and Each to have their Equal
Parts to them & their heirs forever. Lastly I appoint
my Loving Wife Sarah Wingo, Thomas Wingo & John
Wingo Executors & Executrix of This my Last
Will & Testament. Provokeing all former Wills by me
made and declaring This only to be my Last Will &
Testament in Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this Eighth Day of November 1764
