Admors. I will that my debts and funeral Charges shall be paid —
Item I will and bequeath to my Son Thomas One Shilling Sterling
to him and his heirs for ever — Item I will and bequeath to my
Son George One Shilling Sterling to him and his heirs for ever —
Item I will and bequeath to my son William One Shilling
Sterling to him and his heirs for ever — Item I will and bequeath
to my son Nathaniel One Shilling Sterling to him and to his heirs
for ever — Item I will and bequeath to my Daughter Jane
One Shilling Sterling to her and her heirs for ever — Item I give
and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Two negroes Vizt. Aggy and Jack —
Daughter named Lucy also her Choice of a feather bed & furniture as it
stands to her and her heirs for ever — Item I give and bequeath
to my Son John the Land and plantation whereof

One shilling Sterling to her and her heirs for ever — I then give
and bequeath to my Daughter Ann two negroes: Vizt, Agge and For a
Daughter named Lucy, also her Choice of a feather bed & furniture as it
stands to her and her heirs for ever — I then give and bequeath
to my Son John the Land and Plantation whereon I now live &
containing three hundred and thirty Eight Acres to him and his
heirs for ever — I then give and bequeath to my Son John all
the rest of my estate both Real and personal to him and his heirs
for ever — And my will is that my Estate be not brought to
an appraisement — I also constitute and appoint my Son John
whole and Sole Executor of this my last will and Testament —
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
fifteenth day of September In the year of our Lord 1758.
