known his my last Will & Testament by me made this 14th day
I Give & Recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God
that gave it & my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a
Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
named & also my worldly Estate which God has given
to me I Give Devise & Dispose of in form & manner
following

In witness Whereof I set my hand

unto my three sons. Thomas Jackson. John Jackson & Will-
iam Jackson Five Hundred acres of Land to be equally di-
vided between them It being in the Parish of Mount Airy and
on the North side of the Currier Creek & being taken from
five & one hundred acres of Land belonging Charles
Jacksons Line to be divided Equally as he before mentioned
Land was divided May I will & desire is that my eldest son
have his part with the Plantation my son John his part
in the middle & likewise my son William have his
part at the upper end of my Land. To be divided by Equally
Equally by me & approved — I am my desire
is that if either of my sons die without Lawful Issue then there
part & parts be divided between them also the one hundred
of Charles Jacksons Line as the former was to

cast efforts, divided between them also the moment
young Charles Jackson line as the former has to
them their lives forever — I am I leave unto my
Dearly Beloved Wife Amy Jackson During her natural
life or widowhood the best of all kind's nature
& quality to ever my wife shall have the liberty to feed any
of her children with any thing that she can conveniently
share Only they shall account for the same being happy
their portion — Item I last of all do Ordain constitute
& appoint my two Brothers William Jackson & Charles Jackson
to be my whole sole Executors my last Will Testament & to
ing & in making all & every other Will by me made. In
