I Thomas Lowry of Amelia County being very sick of Body but of perfect & sound mind & memory do make and constitute this my Last Will & Testament in manner and form following (Vizt^{ly}) Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved Wife Frances Lowry my Riding Chair & 2 horses also one third part of my personal Estate except Negroes also one third part of my Land & Negroes during her Natural life

Item I give to my son Thomas Lowry all my Land to him and his heirs forever And further my Will and desire is that the Slaves above bequeathed should be equally Divided between my two Children or their Representatives after my said Wifes decease.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Nephew John Tabb my Riding Saddle & Waring Apparel except Linen My Will and desire is that all the Remainder part of my Estate should be Equally divided between my two Children when my Daughter shall arrive to the age of Twenty one Years or Married. I Will that my Executors

hereafter named should work the slaves on the above mentioned
Lands or otherwise as they shall think most proper I appoint Col:
Thomas Tabb John Tabb of Amelia and my Nephew John Tabb
Executors of this my Last Will & Testament In Witness
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand this seventh day September
One Thousand seven hundred and sixty six.
