Gun Bayonet and Cartouch Box

Item I give or lend unto my wife Mary Parore for
and During her life (in view and in full of her
Dower) the use of my negro woman Agg with her
future Increase if any there shall be also the
plantation with all my stock of Horses Cattle &
Hogs (my Black Horse Campy excepted and also
all my Household and Kitchen furniture -
except the bed &c^{co} given as above to my son Herbert
which said negro woman and her future -

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all my Household and Kitchen furniture -
except the bed ^{tho} given as above to my son Herbert
which said negro woman and her future -
Increase and also the Stock of Horses Cattle &
Hogs after my said wifes decease its my Will
and Desire may be equally Divided amongst my

Kitchen furniture amongst my three Daughters having
before given my son abed ^{the} as above It is my will and desire
that my son be sent ~~three~~ years, to school and my Daughters
two years each — Item I give unto my son Herbert Cavor
all my Carpenters Coopers and Turners Tools which I
desire may be sold by executor or Administrator for
his Profit and also my black Horse Compay to be
Likewise sold for his my said sons benefit I also give
unto my said son all the money that may be due to
me from Mr. Thomas Williams and Charles Westbrook
after Deducting the expence of Schooling my said
children as before directed and having my funeral
expences and my just Debts and lastly I do constitute
nominate and ~~appoint~~ ^{constitute} Mr. Thomas Williams whole &
Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all former wills ^{the} by me made
in which whered I have herunto set my hand
affixed my Seal this second day of July one thousand
Seven hundred and sixty eight
