Land to him & his heirs forever. Item I give my Son Thomas Roberts Two
hundred acres of Land Joining his brother Alexanders Land to him & his
heirs forever. Item I give my Son Frances Two hundred acres of Land
it being where I now live to him & his heirs forever my Will & Desire is
if Either of my Sons should dye before he come to the Age of Twentyone
