Pounds, I give to Charity Blanford, Richard Jones, Uriah
Jones, William Greenwood, Thomas Hamm William Southall
& Judith Burton to each Ten Pounds, I give to Nancy
Booker the Sum of Sixty Pounds to be laid out in a Negro
Girl & Fifteen Pounds for her to buy Mourning I give
unto my Son John all the Remainder of my Estate —
to him and his Heirs for ever but in case of his Death —
without an Heir Lawfully begotten of his Body then and
in that case I give all that part of my Estate to be —
Equally divided amongst all the Children that my Daughters

equally divided amongst all the Children that my Daughter
Mary Marshall Bolling has and may have when they
arrive to the Age of Eighteen Years unto them and their
Heirs for ever My Will and desire is that there shall be
no Appraisement of my Estate and my Executors shall not
give any Security for my Estate, my Will and desire is that
Richard Pringle, Richard Booker, Alexander M^r. Nabb -
and John King shall carry on the busin^gs at my different
Stores without delay in the same manner as they think
I would ~~was~~ I to continue living until the Arrival of my
Son John in Virginia, after which time my Son John is
to have the whole Management of my Estate and in case
my Son John should not come to Virginia then and in that
Case Robert Bolling is to have the Management of my
Estate I do hereby Appoint my Son John Tabb, my Son
in Law Robert Bolling and my Friend Richard Pringle
Executors of this my last Will In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Thirtieth Day
