Yarborough and to his heirs for ever with all her Increase
Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Yarborough

one negro Girl named Jude one feather bed and furniture
two Cows and calves all which estate I give to her the said
Jane and to her heirs for ever when she shall come to age

One negro Girl called Lode ~~one feather bed and furniture two~~
Cows and calves when she shall come to age or marry
all which estate I give her the said Catherine and her heirs

personal except a Stallion Colt which I desire my son
to sell for the best price he can get, all which estate I
give to my said Son Archibald and to his heirs for
ever But my will is that my wife Harriah Yarborough

give to my said son Archibald and to his heirs for
ever But my will is that my wife Hanniah Yarbrough
have a maintenance suitable to the ability of the estate
given my son Archibald and out of the said estate also
the use of one negro woman named Oney during her
natural life and the stallion colt above mentioned
to be sold and the money arising from the sale
Desire may be applied towards Discharging my just -
Debts - and I do hereby constitute and appoint my
Friend Robert Munford my sole and sole Executor
of this my last will and Testament
