and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
do hereby make an Ordain this to be my last Will & Testament
that is to say first I Recommend my Soul into the
hands of Almighty God that gives it and my Body to I recom-
mend to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my Children
not doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God and as touching my Worldly
Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this
life I Give and Give and dispose of the same in the following

that is to say I first I recommend my Soul into the
hands of Almighty God that gives it and my Body to I recom-
mend to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my Children
not doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God and as touching my Worldly
Estate wherewith it hath pleased ^{the Almighty} God to bless me with in this
life I give and demise and dispose of the same in the following
Manner and form — I give ^{I give} to my Son Isham Clements
two Negroes to wit, Ned and old Phillis and the land I formerly
by ~~last~~ containing 275 acres and all my Smiths tools and
my part of the mill with ten acres of land joining the mill
house and I desire that my Son Isham Clement may keep my
hole Estate together and not divide till my debts be paid

by the mill and by the negroes work working the negroes as they
stand not interrupting my wife of her house wench nor her
affairs ~ Item I give to my daughter Mary Clement one
Negro to wit, Jean and the Young Sorrel Mare and Sidesa-
dle and bridle and the bed in the little Room and all the
furniture belonging thereto. ~ Item I give to my Daugh-
ter Martha Clement one Negro to wit, Cate and the
best bed up Stairs with all the furniture belonging thereto
and the Roan Horse ~ Item I give to my son
William Clements two negroes to wit, James & Hannah
and the Land tract of George Evans containing 150 Acres
and the bed by the Chimney up Staires which he lies on and
all the furniture belonging thereto and the Horse Coll. and my
Saddle and bridle and Six Heads of Cattle and my Gun.

all the furniture belonging thereto and the House hold and my
Saddle and bridle and Six Head of Cattle and my Gun. —

Item I Give to my Daughter Rebekah Clement One Negro
to wit, Young Phillis and a Good Bed or Ten pounds Cash,

Item I Give to my Son Edmund Walker Clement two
Negroes to wit, Sam and Ben. —

Item I Give to
my Son John Clement two Negroes to wit, Lucy & Young Caesar

Item I Give to my Daughter Ann Clement One Negro
to wit, Sarah. — Item, I Send to my Loving Wife

Ann Clement three Negroes to wit, Daniel and old
Caesar and Temp and the Land and plantation where I now

live with all the rest of my Estate not before mentioned all
which I send to her during her Natural Life or Widowhood and after

Death or marriage my Will and desire is that the part of my
Estate which I lent to my Loving Wife may be equally divided
between my four Children Rebecca, Edmund, John &
Ann except my land & that I give to my Son Edmund and
John the land where I now live the other part of this
Legacy to be divided between the fore mentioned and I do
Appoint my Loving Wife Ann Clement Executrix for
Edmund Walker Clement & John Clement and for Ann
Clement and I do appoint my Son John Clements
Executor for the rest of my Children Mary, Martha, William
Rebecca & this my last Will and Testament
