 Ordain this to be my last will & Testament that is to say  
 Principally I give And Recommend my soul into the Hands  
 of Almighty god that gave it & my body I recommend to the  
 earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executors not Doubting but at  
 the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the  
 Almighty Power of God and as touching my Worldly Estate  
 wherewith it hath pleased the Almighty god to bless me with  
 in this life I give & Devise & Dispose of the same in the  
 following manner To wit.

Item I give to my son Benjamin Clement Two Negroes to wit  
 John & Jess all which I give to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my son Wm Clement Cesar & Philis all  
which I give to him this heirs for ever

Item I give to my son John Clement Two Negroes to wit  
Ned & Judy paying Twenty <sup>Pounds</sup> back to the Estate all which  
I give to him this Heirs for ever.

Item I give to my son Francis Clement Two Negroes to  
wit Genbrey & Hannah also the Land & Plantation &  
Mill where I now Dolve Containing three hundred  
Acres by Estimation to him this Heirs for ever.

I also give to my son Francis Clement this Heirs for  
ever one Hundred & fifty Acres of Land which I bought  
of George Ruins whereon the said George Ruins now do  
live the said Land being not yet conveyed to me for  
which my will is that my Estate pay the Remainder  
of the Purchase money & Desire that the said Ruins  
convey the same by Deeds to my son Francis Clement  
And that my son Francis shall <sup>pay</sup> thirty Pounds to the  
Estate at the Death of my Wife.

Item I lend to my Daughter Elizabeth Ellison Two Negroes  
to wit During her Natural life Gin & Davey after her  
Decease I give Gin to Anne Ford Daughter of Hyebriah  
Ford Deceased & Davey to Hyebriah Ford son of the said  
Hyebriah Deceased.

Item I lend to my Daughter Marshaba Major During  
her Natural life Two Negroes to wit Peter & Sarah and  
Five Pounds current Money & at the decease of the  
said I give the said Negroes & money to be equally

I also give to my son Francis Clement His Heirs for ever one Hundred & fifty Acres of Land which I bought of George Rims whereon the said George Rims now do live the said Land being not yet conveyed to me for which my will is that my Estate pay the Remainder of the Purchase money & Desire that the said Rims convey the same by Deeds to my son Francis Clement And that my Son Francis shall <sup>pay</sup> thirty Pounds to the Estate at the Death of my Wife.

IEM I lend to my Daughter Elizabeth Ellipson Two Negroes to wit Durning her Natural life Gin & Davey after her Decease I give Gin to Anne Ford Daughter of Hezekiah Ford Deceased & Davey to Hezekiah Ford son of the said Hezekiah Deceased.

IEM I lend to my Daughter Sarahaba Major During her Natural life Two Negroes to wit Peter & Sarah and Five Pounds current Money & at the decease of the said Sarahaba I give the said Negroes & money to be equally Divided Amongst all her Children.

IEM I give to my Daughter Ann Bigg Two Negroes to wit Ben & Lucy all which I give to her Her Heirs for ever.

IEM I lend to my <sup>Wife</sup> loving Ann Clement During her Natural life all my whole Estate as well the Part before Disposed of as the Part not already Disposed of &

at her Decease my will is that the Land I bought of W<sup>m</sup> Prof  
and all my estate not given or Legacy be sold to the highest  
Bidders and be Equally Divided Amongst my Seven Children.  
Item my will I Desire is that there be no Appraisment  
nor no Inventory Returned to the Court.

Item I Constitute & Appoint my Son John Clement and my  
son Francis Clement my sole & sole Exors of this my last will  
& Testament & hereby Disannul and Revoche I make  
Void all other Forms Wills and Testaments Legacys and  
Bequiffs by me any Ways before named Ratifying and  
Confirming this and no Other to be my last Will and  
Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
Hand and Seal the Day & year Above written Further my  
Will is that no Account of mine stand against any of my  
Children.
