 one Negro Girl named Log with her Increase also one Furni-
 ture to her & the heirs of her body

I then Give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Rachel Ballard
 two hundred Acres of land being Part of the Tract of Land
 bequeathed my daughter Rachel also one Negro Girl named
