Disposing all other Willows whatsoever, And I do appoint my
three Brothers John Joshua George Fichtners to be my Executors
of this my last Will & Testament and all that it hath been in the
words will to endow me with I give and dispose of in manner
Following. Item first of all I give and bequeath my Spirit
into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my Body to be
buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my
Executors. Item I leave to my dear beloved Wife Susannah
Fichtner during her widow hood or life the plantation
whereon I now live and one negro fellow named Harry also
one negro woman named Vann and the Cattle Hogs & sheep
& House hold furniture.
Item I leave to my daughter Mary and two Negroes one
fellow named Combs & one named Frank to be sold by
my Executors to discharge my Debt.

Item I leave the land I have lent to my Wife after her time
to be sold by my Executors and the money with all the Goods
and Chattels and negroes I now own except two I have left
to be sold and shall raise from this time till the division to be
Equally divided among my dear beloved Children John
Mary William Thomas Daniel Betty Stephen Suannah
Probley and if either of them should die before they come
to a proper age there part or parts to be divided among
all the Remainders. Item if Martins Land should
ever come into my Estate I leave it to be sold by my
Executors and I leave all the Horses except the white
mair and the Black one to be sold by Executors as Witnesses
my Hand this 16th Day of May 1764.
