Item I give and bequeath to my son Ambrose Hutchinson two negro children of Lucy to wit Wiltine and Jacob Item I give and bequeath to my son Drury Hutchinson my negro woman Lucy all the rest and residue of my Estate of what ever kind or nature I desire may be Equally divided between my three children before mentioned to wit Charles Hutchinson Ambrose Hutchinson and Drury Hutchinson I Constitute my son Charles Executor In Witness whereof I have signed Sealed and Acknowledged this to be my last will and testament this thirty first day of July in the year of our Lord 1792 as
