understanding & not hereby make this my Last Will & Testament
in manner & form following that is to say First & principally I
commit my soul to the Almighty God & my body to the Earth
here to be decently Buried according to the Discretion of my
Executor hereafter mentioned

And I do hereby bequeath unto my Son & nephew
William Pry son of my Brother Chas. Pry Decd a Tract of
Land in Brunswick County upon both sides of the Oak Branch of
Mentmore Creek containing one Hundred acres also three
Negroes to wit Peter, Joe & Mark & known the stock & now
the Furniture & belonging to me on the said Plantation to him
the said William Pry

old furniture belonging to me on this day I station them
his heirs for ever — Item I Give & Bequeath
unto Henrietta Maria Juby & another of my Brother Charles
Juby's Deed One Negro fellow named Jack who has been
freed — Item my Will & bequeath in case my good wife
Juby dies before he comes of age or without lawful issue, in that
case I desire what I have Requested to him should be Equally divided
between my Brother Charles Juby's three Daughters that is now
single which is Mary Juby, Martha Juby & Henrietta Maria Juby
the mother of the Children to have any ^{to inherit} portion or Right of my
Estate that I have Requested to them until their mother's death
namely Juby's decease When I Give the Estate of my Estate to
During her life — Lastly I appoint John Wier of Florida
County Esq^r of this my last Will & Testament, as my Executor
And Seal this the fourteenth day of April One thousand
Seven hundred & Sixty three
