Mosley & her Heirs forever.

Item I give my negro man named Matthew to Martha
Mosley Wife to Matthew Mosley & her Heirs forever after
my said Wife's decease.

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Ligon Wife to Benjamin
Pound currently Honey of Virginia also one Bed & furniture
as it stands as also four cows of four Calves to be delivered after
my said Wife's decease.

Item I give to my Grandson Joseph Ligon two cows of two
Calves to be delivered after my Wife's decease.

Item I give to my William Ligon all the rest of my Estate of
Negro's and all the rest of my movable Estate to him my said
Son William Ligon & to his Heirs forever.

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my said son William
Ligon whole & sole Executor of this my last Will or Wills to be
by me made & in and with him to be performed & he and with him or

Whence I like to call them. Now by & to her heirs forever after
my said Wife's decease.

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Ligon this to her heirs
sound & firm in Money of Virginia also once Bed & furniture
as it stands as also four cows & four calves to be delivered after
my said Wife's decease.

Item I give to my Grandson Joseph Ligon two cows & two
calves to be delivered after my Wife's decease.

Item I give to my William Ligon all the rest of my Estate of
Negroes and all the rest of my movable Estate to him my said
son William Ligon & to his heirs forever.

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my said son William
Ligon whole & sole ^{Testament} Executor of this my last Will or Wills to be long
by me made signed with my own hand & sealed with my own
Seal the day & year being first above written.

At a Court held for Amelia County the 1st of June 1764. This Will was proved by the oath of Richard Burks & William Ligon two of the Witnesses thereto sworn to by William Ligon the Executor therein named & ordered ^{to be recorded} and on the Motion of the said Executor who entered into & acknowledged Bond with John Bootner his security as the Law directs certificate was granted him for obtaining a probate in due form.

In the name of God. Amen. April 11th 1764. I John Powell sen^r of the County of Amelia being in health therefore calling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament that is to say Principally & first of all I give & Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it & my Body to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive them again by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estate where
