and assigns for ever Item I lend to my dear beloved wife
during her Natural life or Widowhood the Land and
Plantation whereon I now live Containing Seventy five Acres
Three Negroes James Sarah Phila with all my Stock and
Household Goods and after my wifes Decease or Widowhood
Expires I give to my son James Handley and to his heirs and
assigns for ever the negro Girl above mentioned Joe Also after
my Wifes Decease or Widowhood Expires I give to my son Joshua

Mentioned James and Sarah in the bond and settlement in the
deed containing twenty five acres to him and his heirs and assigns for
ever. Also after my Wifes decease or if her widowhood expires I desire that my
stock and household goods may be equally divided between my son
Joshua and my daughter Elizabeth. All Appointments sons and
daughters and Joshua shall take care to this my last Will and
