In the Name of God Amen I William Seaton of
Amelia County being in sick and Weak but of sound and
Perfect Memory do make this my last Will and Testament as
followeth First I desire all my Just Debts and Funeral Expenses
may be paid. Item I give to Stephen Neale Son of my wife
Catharine all my wearing apparell
My will is that my Grey Horse and Silver Watch be sold by my
Executor hereafter mentioned and the money arising by such
Sale to pay to my well beloved Wife Catharine to whom I give
All the remaining part of my Estate except what is hereafter disposed
I give to my wife Catharine Seaton
I give to my friend John Booker son of the Son of Richard
Booker Deceased, Two pounds current money and I do
constitute and appoint him the said John Booker Executor of
this my last Will. Revoking all other wills heretofore by me

made In Witness whereof I have this 21 day of December 1752
set my hand and Seal
