Boy Named Jupiter to Her and Her Heirs for ever

I give to my dear beloved Wife Elmina Farbrongh all the profits and means of my
work I take together with the work and labour of two Negroes Peter and Phillis during
his unwholeness, and when the whole may continue in her Infirmary as long as
she continues a Slave and when she dies, my Will and Desire
is that all my Personall Estate in Goods and Chattels be Equally Divided between
every one of my beloved Children, Anne Higgins Elminet Farbrongh Mary Ann
and Elizabeth, William Farbrongh Stephaen Farbrongh Isaac Farbrongh
Michael Farbrongh Rosella Farbrongh to them and their Heirs

I give and bequeath to my beloved Son Michael Farbrongh four hundred
Acres of Land where I now live together with the Plantation and all the
improvements thereon to him and his Heirs forever.

I stand my beloved Grand Daughter Rosella Robertson One Negro girl
Named Hannah during life and she should have a Christen name together
of her Body. When give the said Hannah and her Increase to the said
Rosella Robertson and her Heirs forever but if she dies without Heir
lawfully begotten my Will and Desire is that the said Negro Hannah
and her Increase return to my Children and to be Equally Divided
between them Each of them

I likewise constitute make and appoint my dear beloved Wife Elmina Farbrongh
and my beloved Sons William Farbrongh and Stephaen Farbrongh whole
sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament Concerning this and
no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this thirteenth Day of July One thousand
seven hundred and forty eight.

I give and bequeath to my four Sons James Farbrongh William Farbrongh
Ezekiah Farbrongh and Moses Farbrongh four hundred Acres of Land of the
South side of Little Northony River joining the lands of Robert Bumpass
John Dyers and James Hudson to be Equally Divided to them and their
Heirs
