securities entered into & acknowledged bond in the penalty
of one thousand pounds, with the condition required
by law, and took the oath of an Executor as prescribed

seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and twenty six

bound Ruben Harrison Exec^t. of the last will and testament of
Battaille Harrison deceased do make or cause to be made a true
and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels
and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come
