 fifty pounds, to the payment Whereof well and truly to be
 made to the said Justices and their successors we bind ourselves
 and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and
 Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents
 sealed with our Seals this fifth day of May in the Year
 of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and seventy seven
 and in the first Year of the Common Wealth

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the
 above bound Thomas Pannell his Executors and administrators
 shall well and truly pay and deliver or cause to be paid
 and delivered, unto John Campbell Infant Orphan of
 George Campbell Dec^d. all such Estate or Estates as now is
 or are or hereafter shall appear to be due to the said Orphan
 when and as soon as he shall attain to Landed age
 or when there is required by the Justices of the said County
 Court, or also keep harmless the above named Justices
 their and every of their heirs Executors & administrators from
 all Trouble and expences that shall or may arise about the
 said Estate then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain
 in full force
