my Loving Wife Mary share and share alike to them & their

The condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Mary Berryford the Younger Administrator with the Will Annexed of all the Goods Chattels and Credits of John Berryford Deceased do make or Cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and Singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deed which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Mary or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her and the same so made do Exhibit or Cause
