New England in the Sum of one hundred and fifty pounds

Current money of Virginia to the payment whereof with
and Truly to be made to the Said Justices and their Successors
we bind ourselves and each of us, our heirs, each of our heirs
Executors and Administrators jointly and Severally firmly
by these presents Sealed with our Seals this first day of
July in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred
and Seventy Six and in the 16th year of the Reign of our
Sovereign Lord George the Third

The Condition of this obligation is Such that if the
Above bound William Saine admint^r of all the goods & Chattels
Credits of John Lavender De^d do make or Cause to be
made a true and perfect Inventory of all and Singular
the Goods Chattels and Credits of the Said deceased which
have or Shall Come to the hands possession or knowledge of
him the Said William Saine or into the hands and
possession of any other person or persons for him
and the Same so made do Exhibit or Cause to be Exhibited
into the County Court of Amherst at Such time as shall
be thereunto required by the Said Court and the Same
Goods Chattels and Credits and all Other the Goods
Chattels and Credits of the Said Deceased at the time
of his death which at any Time after Shall Come to the
Hands or possession of the Said William Saine or into
the hands or possession of any Other person or persons
for him do well and Truly administer according to Law
and farther do make a just and true account of his doings
and Doing therein when thereto required by the Said Court
and all the rest and residue of the Said Goods Chattels & Credits

(913) which shall be found remaining upon the Said adminⁿ Account
the Same being first Examined and allowed by the Justices of
the Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such
person or persons respectively as the Said Justices by their order
or Judgment shall direct pursuant to the Law in that Case
made and provided, and if it shall hereafter appear that
any Last will and Testament, was made by the Said deceased
and the Executor or Executors therein named do Exhibit
the Same into the Said Court making request to have it
allowed and approved Accordingly if the Said William
Laine being there unto required to render and Deliver
up his Letters of administration approbation of Such
Testament being had and made in the Said Court then
this obligation to be Void and of none Effect or else to
remain in full force and Virtue
