January in the Year of our Lord MDCCLXX & Valentine Ball
of Amherst Planter being very sick and weak in Body but of perfect
mind and memory thanks be given unto God for the same & Calling
to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my
last Will and Testament That is to say Principally & first of all
I Give & Recommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it
and for my Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a
Christian like & Decent manner at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive
the same again by the mighty power of God. and as Touching such
worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this
Life I Give Devise & Dispose of the same in manner & form
following that is to Say

In the first place after my Debts are paid I lend all & singular
my whole Estate to Susanna Ball my well beloved wife
during her natural Life

I also Give & bequeath to James Ball Lewis Ball Alice Wright
Sarah Bowman Susana Haighe Elizabeth Haigh John Ball
& Mary Hargrove one Shilling Sterling each to be paid out of my
Estate

I also Give to William Ball my well beloved son the Land and
Plantation whercon I now live after his mothers decease
