In the name God amen I Pearce Wade of the County of Amherst being weak in body but of sound memory (Pleased be God) do this 13th (Day of Dec^r in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty nine make & Publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner Following Infirmities I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my Body to the Earth to be Decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named. Item after my just and Lawfull Debts are paid by my Executors. Item my will is that my wife Elizabeth Wade have a Quiet Possession on the Plantation whereon I now live with a Decent Livelyhood as long as she remains a widow & also I leave her my Bed & furniture During Widowhood Item I give to my Daughter Susanna Wade when my youngest Child comes of age and Equal Part in my Estate to her ~~other~~ heirs Lawfully begotten. Item my Daughter Elizabeth I leave five Shillings for her Legacy is paid & likewise my Daughter Abigail Hardwick is paid Item my will is that my whole Estate be kept together till my youngest Child comes of age and then my Land Stock & Negroes to be sold & Equally Divided amongst my Children together with all my Household furniture Lastly I make & ordain Ambrose Pucker Rich^d Peter
