In the name of God Amen I Frances
Wright of Amherst County & Parish do make and order
this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form
as Followeth. Item I give to my oldest son Benjamin
Wright forty Shillings Sterling Item I give to my
Daughter Anner Waters one Shilling I give to my
Daughter Elizabeth Morris one Shilling I give to my
Daughter Mary Shelton one Shilling I give to my Son
Thos. Wright one Shill. I give to my son Moses Wright
one Shill. Also I give to my son John Wright a Negro
Gul named Lucy her and her seed for him and his
Heirs forever. I give to my son Isaac Wright all the
rest of my Estate (Viz) Land & Side, Umphreys Pasture
and Pasture. I constitute nominate & Appoint my
well beloved Sons Isaac Wright & John Wright
Executors of this my Last Will & Testament Revoking
all former Wills. in Witness whereof I have hereunto
Set my Hand and Seal This Ninth day of December 1766

The Last Will & Testament of Francis Wright Dec. was
Presented in Court by Isaac Wright one of the Executors -
Therein named & Proved by the Oaths of David Woodroff &
John Waters two of the Witnesses thereto & Ordered to be
Recorded. and on the Motion of the said Executor who
made Oath according to Law. Certificate is granted
him for Obtaining Probate thereof in due form giving
Security. Whereupon he together with David Woodroff
John

Job Carter and Peter Carter his Securities entered into and
Acknowledged their Bond in the Penalty of three Hundred
Ex^d Pounds with Condition required by Law.

Thomas Goley's Will
In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Goley
of the County of Amherst and Colony of Virginia being
very Sick & weak of Body but of perfect mind & Memory
Thanks be to God I do constitute & Ordain this my Last
Will & Testament in manner & Form as following
First I give my Soul to God that gave it and my Body
to be buried in a Decent Christian manner at the
Discretion of my Friends. Secondly my desire is that
all my Debts shall be shortly paid. Thirdly my desire
is that my brother Abraham Nalley shall possess my
Horse bridle & Saddle with all my wearing cloaths.
Fourthly my desire is that I lend to my mother one half of
the Rent of Estate during her Natural Life and then to be
Equally divided among my Sister Sarah Craeford's
Children. Fifthly I lend the other half to my Sister
Sarah Craeford during her Natural Life and then to be
Equally Divided amongst her Children I disannul all
other former Wills and Ordain this Only to be my Last
Will & Testament as Witness my hand this Twentyfour
Day of April 1767
