 by these presents Sealed with our Seals this Third Day of August
 In the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy Eight
 and in the third year of the Commonwealth

That the OBLIGATION of this Obligation is Such that
 Sarah McCabe Administratrix of all the
 goods Chattels and Credits of Hugh McCabe Deceased do make or
 Cause to be made and perfect Inventory of all and Singular
 the Goods Chattels and Credits of the Said Deceased, which have or
 shall come to the hands, Possession or knowledge of her the said
 Sarah or into the hands or Possession of any other person or persons
 for her and the same so made do Exhibit at Cause to be Exhibited into
 the County Court of Amherst at such time as she shall be thereunto
 Required by the said Court, and the same Goods Chattels and Credits
 and all other the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased at the
 time of his Death which at any time after shall come to the hands
 or Possession of the said Sarah or into the hands or Possession of any
 other person or persons for her do well and truly Administer
 according to Law, and further do make a just and true account of
 her Actings and doings therein when thereto required by the said
 Court, and all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels and
 Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Adminis^r
 Account the same being first Examined and allowed by the Justices
