with Joye and through the merits of Christ's Death and Passion  
possess and Inherit the Kingdom of Heaven prepared for his elect  
and Chosen, and my Body to be Buried in such a place where it shall  
please Executors named to appoint, And now for settling of my  
Temporal Estates, and such Goods, Chattels and Debts, as it hath  
pleased God far above my deserts to bestow upon me, I do

that is to say first I will that all my Debts as I owe in Right  
or Conscience to any manner Person, Persons whatsoever shall  
be well and truly contented and paid or Ordained to be paid within
