 my Temporal affair I heartfully Submit my Eternal
 Concerns to the Wise and Merciful disposer of all things &
 patiently Wait his Mandate for my Great Change & to
 this my last Will & Testament have set my hand at this
 Nineteenth day of May one thousand seven hundred & Eighty
