and it is my desire that my Youngest Children may be educated
from the Labour of the above Mention Slaves Charlotte Melly and
Esther my son Samuel Stewart to have three Years Schooling also
my son David Stewart to have three Years Schooling also my son
Richard Stewart to have three Years Schooling my Daughter Sally
Stewart to have two Years Schooling also it is my desire that my
Wife Ann Stewart should have peaceable Possession of all my
Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs & Sheep so long as she lives also all the
Household Furniture as long as she Liveth and it is my desire at
Her death that all the Estate Both Real & Personable should be
Equally divided among ^{my} Children Charles Stewart John Stewart
James Stewart Robt Stewart Mary Stewart Thomas Stewart
Elizabeth Stewart Ann Stewart Samuel Stewart David Stewart
Sally Stewart Richard Stewart & William Stewart to them &
their Heirs Share & Share alike also I give to my son John Stewart
Three Thousand Seven Hundred & fifty Acres of Land Lying
& Being in Kentucky to Him & his Heirs forever to have and to
Possession I constitute Nomenate and appoint my two Sons
Charles Stewart & John Stewart Executors of this my Last Will
& Testament hereby revoking all former Wills. In Witness

Court by Charles & John Stewart the Executors therein Named & proved by the

said Executors With Jeremiah Taylor & Charles Rose their Sincerely Entered
into and acknowledged their Bond in the Penalty of Five Hundred
Pounds & took the oath required by Law and the said Will was
ordered to be Recorded
