Sum of Five hundred Pounds To the payment whereof well and
truly to be made to the said Justices and their Successors, we
Bind ourselves, and Each of us our and Each of our heirs Executors
and Administrators, Jointly and Severally firmly by these presents
Sealed with our Seals this fourth Day of August in the year of
our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty three, and in the
Eighth year of our Independence

The Condition of this Obligation is Such that if the above Bound
Allen Alley Burton Administratrix of all the Goods Chattles & Credits
of James Alley Burton Deceased do make or cause to be made a
true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattles &
Credits of the said Deceased which at any time after shall come
to the hands Possession or knowledge of the said Allen Alley
Burton or into the hands and possession of any other Person or
Persons for her and the same so made do Exhibit or cause to be
Exhibited into the County Court of Amherst at such time as She
shall be thereunto Required by the said Court, and the same Goods
Chattles and Credits and all other the Goods Chattles and Credits
