

In the Name of God Amen I Martha Hudson of Amhurst County in Colony of Virginia being in perfect sense & sound Memory do make this my last will and testament in the first place I Comitt my soul into the hands of god who gave it & my body to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of the Executors unto my daughter Mary Carter the wife of Griffins Carter I give ten Shillings Sterling unto my daughter Martha Hudson I give all the Rest of my Estate and at her death to do with it as she thinks fit I leave my daughter <sup>Martha</sup> Hudson Executor, William Ware & Edmond Goodrich Executors to my Estate; In witness I set my hand and Seal this thirtieth day of January one thousand Seven hundred & Eighty four

A Court held for Amhurst County the Seventh day of June 1704 This last will and Testament of Martha Hudson Deceased was proved in Court by William Ware one of the Executors therein named and proved by the Oath of James Goodrich and Sanderson Carter Witnesses thereto and the said Executors with John Duncan his security Entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the Penalty of three hundred and forty shillings to keep the Oath Requested by law and Ordered to be Recorded

Know all men by these presents that we William Ware and John Duncan on the one part and legally bound to William Cabell James Dillard Ambrose Rucker John Diggs and Benjamin Rucker Gent. Justices of the Court of Amherst County now sitting in the sum of three hundred pounds to the payment whereof well to be made to the said Justices and their Successors we bind our selves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and Administrators. Jointly and Severally firmly by these presents Sealed with our seals this seventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty four & in the Eight year of the Commonwealth

The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound William Ware Executor of the last will and testament of Martha Hudson Deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels & Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands Possession or knowledge of the said Executor or into the hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for him and the same so made & Exhibited into the County Court of Amherst at such time as he shall be therein Required by the said Court and the same goods Chattels & Credits and all other the goods Chattels & Credits of the said deceased which at any time after shall come to the hands Possession or knowledge of the said Executor or into the hands and Possession of any other person or persons for him do well and Truly administer according to Law and further do make a Just and true account of his doings and disbursements when thereunto Required by the said Court, & also shall well and truly Pay and deliver all the Legacies contained & Specified in the said testament as far as the said goods Chattels & Credits will thereunto Extend and the law shall Charge then this obligation to be Void and of no Effect or Else to Remain in Full Force and Virtue
