 Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive
 the same by the mighty Power of God, and as touching such worldly
 Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me in this Life I
 Dispose of the same in the following manner and form, I Inprimis
 I Lend to my Beloved Wife Tamsay Cash Enduring her Natural Life
 Four hundred Acres of Land wheron I now Live and at her Decease
 Equally Divided between my two Sons Samuel Cash & Barnett
 Cash, To them and their Heirs forever, Item I Lend to my beloved
 Wife Tamsay Cash Six Negroes Namely, John, Pastor, Ailee, Tom,
 Saomey, and Judah, Enduring her Natural Life time and at her
 Decease they and their Increase, Equally Divided among all my
 Children to them and their heirs forever, Item I Lend to my beloved
 Wife Tamsay Cash, Enduring her Natural Life all my Stock & household
 Furniture excepting a Rifle Gun, and at her Decease Equally
 Divided among all my Children To them and their Heirs forever, Item
 I give to my Beloved Son Samuel Cash my Rifle Gun, It is my
 Desire that each of my Children, Namely, Pamela, Sophie, Frances,
 Samuel and Barnett, have Two Years Schooling to be paid out of my
 Estate, Item if any of my above named Children die without
 Issue the above mentioned Estate be Equally Divided among the
 Living, M^r Samuel Higgenbotham, M^r Hendrick Arnold, and ake
 and Ordain with my beloved Wife Tamsay Cash my Sole Executors and
 Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and thereby Revoke
 and Disannull all and every other former Testaments Wills, Requests
 and Executors by me in any ways before this time named Ratifying
 and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In
 Witness whereunto I have Set my hand and Seal In presence of,

This Last Will and Testament of Robert Cash Deceased was present-
ed in Court by the Executors ^{herein} named, and proved by the oath of Caleb
Higgenbotham, Charles Barnes and Thomas Powell Witnesses
thereto, and the said Executors with James Ware, and Thomas
Powell their Securities entered into and acknowledged Bond in
the Penalty of One thousand Pound, and took the oath
Required by Law, and the said Will was ordered to be Read

Now all men by these presents that we Tammy Cash, Hendrick
Arnold, Samuel Higgenbotham, James Ware and Thomas Powell,
are held and firmly Bound to William Cabell, James Dillard, Dan^l.
Gaines, Ambrose Rucker, Rodrick M. Culloch, William
Horsley, Gabriel Penn and Nicholas Cabell, Gentlemen Justices
of the Court of Amherst County, now sitting, in the Sum of One
Thousand Pound, To the payment whereof well and truly to be
made to the said Justices and their successors we bind ourselves
and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and Administrators
Jointly and Severally firmly by these presents sealed with our Seals
this Sixth Day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand seven
hundred and Eighty two and in the Sixth year of our Independence
The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above
Bound Tammy Cash, Hendrick Arnold and Samuel Higgenbotham
Executors of the Last Will and Testament of Robert Cash Deceased
do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and
singular the Goods Chatties and Credits of the said Deceased, which
have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said
Tammy Cash, Hendrick Arnold and Samuel Higgenbotham, or into
the hands and possession of any other person or persons for them
and the same so made do exhibit into the County Court of Amherst
at such time as they shall be thereunto Required by the said Court
and the same Goods Chatties and Credits, and all other the Goods
Chatties and Credits of the said Deceased which at any time after
shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said
Cash, Arnold and Higgenbotham or into the hands & possession
