 Elizabeth Paton Two hundred and fifty four Acres of Land and
 half of my Personal Estate to her and her heirs forever and if
 she Should die without Heir my Will and Desire is to give it to
 Catoran Peggan to her and her heirs forever Item I give to
 John Childers one hundred Acres Land Joining John Goodrich
 and William Ware & Clemmons to him and his heirs forever, &
 I do hereby Revoke all other Wills and Bequeaths and
 Acknowledge this to be my Last Will and Testament. I appoint
 my friends Charles Taliaferro and James Ware Executors to
 this my last Will and Testament. Witnesses my hand and Seal

 and Eighty three
