the same in the following manner and form First I give and
Bequeath to Rebekah Henderson my dearely beloved wife one feather
Bed & furniture my Bay man & Nat Pot one little Pewter dish
and three Pewter Plates during her widowhood I give & Bequeath
to my beloved sons Joel Ponton & Steven Henderson all my horses Minges &
Tenments that I now Possess to be Equally divided at my death Likewise
All my Cattle Hogs Hous hold furniture to be Equally divided And
if the above Bay Man bears the said produce to be Equally divided
between the above Joel Ponton & Steven Henderson if the said Steven
Henderson my son dies without heir that part of my Estate that I gave him
I desire it may be Equally divided among all my Children Excepting Joel
Ponton & his heirs I desire that all my debts may be paid out of the said Estate
and then Equally divided I will that at the death of my wife that all which
my wife be Equally divided between my sons Joel Ponton & Steven Henderson
I desire that Capt John Loving & William Watson Be the Executors of this my
Last will & Testament whereof I have set my hand & seal in the day & year above
written

swear by these presents Seale with our seals this seventh Day of June in the
year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred Eighty Four for the eight
year of the Commonwealth.

The CONDEMNATION of this obligation is such that if the above bound
William Matteson Executor of the Last Will & Testament of William Henderson
Deceased do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all &
singular the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deceased which have or
shall come to the hands of his possession or knowledge of the said Exec or into the
hands of his possession of any other person or persons for him and the same so
made do Exhibit into the County Court of Amherst at such time as he shall
be thereⁱⁿ Required by the said Court & the same goods Chattels & Credits
that other the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deceased which at any time
after shall come to the hands of his possession or knowledge of the said Exec or into
the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him and the
administrator according to Law and further do make a just & true Account of
all his Actions & things thence when thence Required by the said Court and
also shall will H^rly & deliver all the Sagaces contained & specified in the
said Testament as far as the said Goods Chattels & Credits will then unto
and the law shall charge them this obligation to be void & of no effect or else
remain in full force & Virtue
