

I Paul C Cabell of the County of Amherst being of sound mind, do make this my last will & Testament as follows to-wit:

I give to my wife Mary all my personal property of every description whatsoever, also my tract of land lying in the County of Amherst, which I acquired by devise from my father William Cabell, also a small tract of land purchased of William Mercer, for and during her natural life and on the event of her marrying then it is my will that she forfeit all claim to my property both real & personal, and in that event it is my wish that my said property as aforesaid be divided equally among my children share & share alike.

Lastly I constitute & appoint my wife my sole Executrix and do not require of her to give bond and security as Executrix and it is my wish that no inventory be taken of my Estate given under my hand. Witness her 5th day of May 1836

At a Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery convened by adjournment and held for the County of Amherst at the Court house on Monday the 5th day of September 1836. The last will and Testament of Paul C Cabell dec^d was this day produced into Court, proved by the Oaths of C. D. Atchell and Warner Jones witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And at a Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery convened by adjournment and held for the County of Amherst at the Court house on Friday the 9th day of September 1836. On the motion of Mary C Cabell the Executrix named in the said will who made oath thereto and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$30,000 conditioned as the law directs, but without securing it appearing to the Court by the said will that the Testator did not wish his Executrix to

my property both real & personal, and in that event it is my wish that my said property as aforesaid be divided equally among my children share & share alike.

Lastly I constitute & appoint my wife my sole Executrix and do not require of her to give bond and security as Executrix and it is my wish that no contrary be taken of my Estate given under my hand & seal this 5th day of May 1836

At a Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery convened by adjournment and held for the County of Amherst at the Court house on Monday the 5th day of September 1836 The last written Testament of Paul C Cabell dec^d was this day produced into Court & proved by the Oaths of Edw^d Atchell and Warner Jones witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And at a Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery convened by adjournment and held for the County of Amherst at the Court house on Friday the 9th day of September 1836 On the motion of my P^r Obedience the Executrix named in the said will who made oath thereto and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$30,000 conditioned as the law directs but without securing it appearing to the Court by the said will that the Testator did not wish his Executrix to give security and by the Oath of a witness that the Estate was not indebted to any considerable extent certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate of said will in due form.
