Your Commissioner of accounts reports to the Court that on the 8th day of May 1877 William D. State Executor of Alexander Hunter, deceased, exhibited before your Commissioner a Statement of all the money which he the said William D. State Executor as aforesaid had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed on account of that portion of the Estate of the said Alexander Hunter, deceased, which was located in the State of Virginia since the 7th day of February 1849 together with the vouchers for such disbursements.

That your Commissioner embodied the said Executor in the list of fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Court House of said County on the first day of June Court 1877, and on the date of this report ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list made up and completed on account of the said William D. State's administration of the said Estate, and on the 7th day of August 1877, finds that the said Estate was closed by the said Executor paying to the distributees thereof the balance in his hands.

The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers and is herewith returned. Your Commissioner finds the security to be unobjectionable and fully sufficient.

Reference being respectively made to the settlement of the accounts of the said Executor before the Orphans Court of Washington City, certified copies of said settlements are herewith filed.
