Diack all of my property, real and personal, to be equally divided among them, share and share alike, and any of my children being indebted to me on notes or open book account, the said debt so owing is to be taken out of his or her share of my estate.

Thirdly: I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my son, Garrett B. Wibirt executor of this, my last will and testament, and hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and seventy-five.

Commissioner Office Alexandria Virginia February 28th 1870.

To the County Court of Alexandria County. Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 23rd day of August last John R. Johnston the Guardian of Charles Stone exhibited before your Commissioner a statement of all the money which he the said Guardian had received or become chargeable with, or had disbursed within two years beginning on the 7th day of April 1860 and ending on the 7th day of April 1870, together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioner embraced the said Guardian in the list of fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for settlement which was posted at the front door of the Court house of Alexandria County on the first day of October Court last and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed, an account of the said John R. Johnston's guardianship, as aforesaid, and finds that on the 7th day of April 1870 a balance of Principal of \$1880³⁵/₁₀₀ will be due from the said Guardian to the said Ward; and that a balance of profits of \$1539⁷⁵/₁₀₀ will be due from the said Ward, to the said Guardian leaving a final balance of \$341¹⁰/₁₀₀ of Principal due to Charles Stone the said Ward from John R. Johnston the said Guardian. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers and is herewith returned. Your Commissioner further reports to the Court that he has examined whether the said Guardian has given such bond as the law requires, and whether it is in a pecuniary and with securities sufficient, and finds the same to be unquestionable and fully sufficient. Given under my hand as Commissioner of the said Court on the day and year first aforesaid.
