To the Hon. Richard H. Lockenille Judge of the County Court
 of Alexandria County. Your Commissioner of accounts, reports to the
 Court that on the 2^d day of January 1871 William F. Earne the
 Guardian of John H. Baumill Kate F. Rice (formerly Baumill)
 George W. Baumill and Francis P. Baumill infant children of
 Patrick Baumill deceased, exhibited before your Commissioner
 a statement of all the money which he the said Guardian had received
 or become chargeable with, or had disbursed from the 2^d day of
 August 1869 to the 1st day of January 1871 together with the
 vouchers for such disbursements, that the Commissioner embraced
 the said Guardian in the list of Fiduciaries whose accounts
 were before him for settlement which was noted at the front door of the
 Court house of said County on the first day of January Court 1871 and
 on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account
 was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed an account
 of the said William F. Earne's Guardianship as aforesaid, and on the

first day of January 1871 finds a balance of \$42⁶⁸/₁₀₀, including \$39⁷⁵/₁₀₀ invested
 by order of Court due to the said John H. Baumill, a balance of \$4²⁸/₁₀₀ due
 to the said Kate F. Rice (formerly Baumill), a balance of \$28⁰⁰/₁₀₀ due to the
 said George W. Baumill; and a balance of \$10²⁸/₁₀₀ due to the said Francis
 P. Baumill from the said Guardian all principal. The account is supported
 by satisfactory vouchers, and is herewith returned. Your Commissioner further
 reports to the Court that he has examined whether the said Guardian has
 given such bond as the law requires and whether it is in a penalty and
 with sureties sufficient, and finds the same undesignable and fully
 sufficient. Given under my hand as Commissioner of accounts of the
 said Court, on the day and year first aforesaid.
