In the Name of God, Amen. I, Maria C. Jamieson, Widow of the late John Jamieson of Alexandria Virginia, being of sound mind and understanding. And being desirous of settling my worldly affairs, and directing how my property, Real, Personal, and mixed shall be disposed of after my death; while I have strength and capacity to do so. I do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made: And First, I commended my immortal being to him who gave it, and my body to the Earth, to be buried at the direction of my Executors, to be hereinafter named. And all my property, Real and Personal of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death, I devise, bequeath, and dispose of in the manner following, to wit:

Imprimis - My Will is that my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my Executor hereinafter named out of my Estate as soon as convenient. I give bequeath and devise all my property, real, personal and mixed of which I shall die possessed of to my two nephews George W. Jamieson and John Jay Jamieson, Sons of Robert Jamieson their heirs and assigns forever. And I direct that if either of these my said Nephews shall die before the other, that the part or share of him so dying shall go to the survivor of these, his heirs and assigns forever. And lastly, I appoint my Nephew Andrew Jamieson to be the Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal, and published this to be my last Will and Testament, in the presence of the witnesses named below this ninth day of May Eighteen hundred and sixty five.
