I do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made: And First, I commend my immortal being to him who gave it, and my body to the Earth, to be buried at the direction of my Executors, to be hereinafter named. And all my property Real and Personal of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death, I devise, bequeath and dispose of in the manner following. To wit:
Imprimis - My Will is that my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my Executor hereinafter named out of my Estate as soon as convenient. I give bequeath and devise all my property, real, personal and mixed of which I shall die possessed of to my two nephews George W.
