Court that on the 7th day of August, 1868,
John A. Milburn, Guardian under the will

of J. C. Milburn, deceased, of Sarah Florence Milburn, Margaret S. Milburn & Ethelbert Milburn exhibited before your Commission a statement of all the moneys which he the said John C. Milburn had received or become chargeable with, or had disbursed, within the year ending 1st of June, 1868, together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That your Commission embraced the said Guardian, in the list of Fiduciaries, whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Courthouse of said County, on the first day of September, Court last; and on the date of this Report. Six days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in said list, made up and completed the annexed accounts of John C. Milburn Guardian as aforesaid, and on the 1st day of November, 1867 finds a balance of thirty three cents due from Sarah Florence Milburn, who on that day attained majority, and on the 1st day of June, 1868, finds a balance of sixty two dollars and thirty two cents due from the said Guardian to his ward Margaret S. Milburn, and a balance of forty nine dollars and sixty seven cents due from said Guardian to his ward Ethelbert Milburn.
