Your Commissioner reports to the Court, that on the 15th day of April 1868, Samuel W. Chancellor, Guardian of Marie W. Hamilton, in obedience to a summons issued by him on 27th March, 1868, exhibited before your Commissioner, a statement of all the moneys which he the said Lormay W. Chancellor had received or become chargeable with, or had disbursed, within the period which had elapsed since his qualification in 1859, as such Guardian, together with the vouchers for such disbursements. - That your Commissioner introduced in the said Guardian in the list of Fiduciaries, whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Court House of said County, on the first day of May Court last, and on the date of this Report, 1 line days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in said list I made up and completed the annual account of said Guardian, and on the 25th day of April 1868, found a balance of \$346.70 due by him to his Ward.
