That your Commissioner embraced the said Administration in the list of Administrators whose accounts were before him for attestation, which said list was recited at the front door of the Court house of said County, on the first day of the February term of the said Court for 1867. and that on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned, in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing account of the said Sarah C. Bowden Administratrix of the estate of the said Alexander Bowden deceased, and now on this twenty first day of October A. D. 1867. finds a balance due said Administratrix of two hundred and twenty nine ⁴³/₁₀₀ dollars (\$229. ⁴³/₁₀₀) she having expended that amount over and above the amount she had received from said deceased estate.
